COVID-19 PROTOCOLS; LIABILITY WAIVER

To prioritize the health and safety of all attendees and participants during our Annual Conference and all related UnidosUS events (collectively, the “Event”), UnidosUS will be implementing health and safety protocols for everyone attending the event in-person. UnidosUS is closely following the requirements imposed by the San Antonio, Texas and our venue as well as the recommendations from the CDC. **Given the evolving nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, these protocols are subject to change, based on local mandates, without notice.** Compliance with these protocols will be mandatory for attendance and participation at the event.

Please note, UnidosUS reserves the right to implement any protective measures that it deems necessary to protect everyone attending the event. UnidosUS also reserves the right to reduce capacity or transition to a virtual experience at any time to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Pre-Event Requirements

- Proof of full vaccination is required to attend.
 - Fully vaccinated means a person has received their primary series of COVID-19 vaccines, per the [CDC guidelines](#).
 - Proof of vaccination requires a valid photo ID and original, copy or electronic photo of the CDC vaccination card.
- For the health and safety of yourself and our fellow attendees, we strongly encourage attendees who have been in high-risk environments as deemed by local health agencies to get tested 24 hours prior to joining us as a courtesy to our fellow attendees.
- If an attendee has or experiences any symptoms of COVID-19 within 24 hours prior to event date, the attendee agrees not to travel and/or attend public events.
 - These include, but are not limited to: fever, dry cough, tiredness, aches and pains, sore throat, headache, loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath.
